Act Size and Length:

- Acts may be presented by an individual or a group.
 - *Group acts should be limited to a maximum of five participants.*
- The time for each act can range from 3-5 minutes. Participants will have a one minute warning and then the act will be called at 5 minutes.



Share - the - Fun: *Categories*


Instrumental:
Musical instruments of all descriptions.

Vocal:
Singing numbers.

Dance:
All dance, baton, and acrobatic routines.

Dramatic and Novelty:
Skits, stunts, pantomimes, monologues, puppetry, ventriloquism, impersonations, etc.

General:
Acts which include two or more of the above classifications.



County Events Benefit to Youth

Increase self-esteem
 Improve writing skills
 Develop confidence in front of audience
 Skill development
 Stage annually to practice public speaking

Summary

Provide youth with the opportunity to develop their public speaking skills.

Share skills learned in the arts: theatre, photography, and posters.
