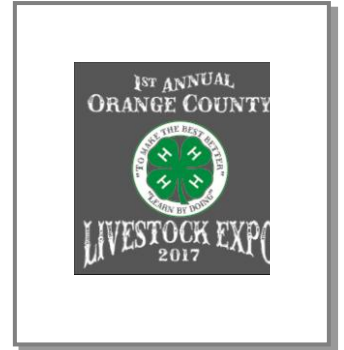


Only animals being entered and shown at the Orange County-H Livestock Expo are permitted on the grounds at any time.

Rabbits will be shown on Saturday October 28, 2017

Check in is from 8:00 – 9:00

There will be no cages available you will be in your own cages for the day.
Please bring water and feed if needed.



Maximum of 5 animals per exhibitor: 5 Rabbit and 5 Cavy

1. \$5.00 per rabbit/cavy entry fee required at time of entry
2. **Entry deadline date is Friday, October 06, 2017 ! .**
3. Rabbits may be entered: BUCK OR DOE. No neutered rabbits will be shown.
4. Cavy may be entered by BOAR OR SOW
5. Only purebred animals can be shown. No animals under 12 weeks will be eligible to show.
6. All animals will be up held to and judged from the basis of the ARBA's "Standard of Perfection." It is highly encouraged and recommended to keep up-to-date on the current recognized breeds. Please visit <https://www.arba.net/breed/html>
7. No sick or diseased animals will be allowed in the show area. It is highly suggested that each exhibitor check his/her animals ears for ear mites, canker (a few drops of baby oil in the ears a few weeks prior to the show will help prevent disqualification of your animal).

Pee-Wee Program

1. Pee-Wee: age between 5 – 7yrs, as of September 1, 2017.
2. Pee-Wee showmanship will not be judged; it is for exhibition purposes only.
3. Ribbons will be awarded.

Rabbit & Cavy Showmanship

The main objective in being a good showman is to present the animal to the judge in the best possible manner. The exhibitor must be courteous, attentive (keep their eyes on the judge) and demonstrate knowledge of their project.

2. Classes will be determined by age divisions; junior, intermediate & senior divisions.
3. Official dress is required.
4. Exhibitor must show their own rabbit/cavy.
5. Animals must be entered in the show to be shown.
6. Awards will be given to the top 3 places in each age division; junior, intermediate, and senior.
