What is Share The Fun?

- Share the Fun is a creative arts showcase intended to help 4-H members discover, develop, and share their talents with a larger audience. The objective of the Share the Fun Program is to enhance the following areas: appreciation of talent, leadership, confidence, interest in special training, and the ability to discover opportunities for wholesome recreation.



Participation Criteria



- The County Level Share the Fun competition is open to all registered Orange County members. All entrants must complete a registration.
- Youth have the option of presenting a group act (maximum of five participants), provided that all group members are in the same age division, or individually.

Regulations

- No living vertebrates.
- Participants must provide all equipment and supplies for their presentations.
- The time range for each act can range from 3-5 minutes. Participants will have a one minute warning and then time will be called at 5 minutes.
- Please be aware of the stage size and requirements for your exhibition.



Act Classification

- Instrumental: Musical Instruments of all descriptions
- Vocal: Singing numbers
- Dance: All dance, baton, and acrobatic routines.
- Dramatic and Novelty: skits, stunts, pantomimes, monologues, puppetry, ventriloquism, impersonations, etc.
- General: acts which include two or more of the above classifications.



Awards

- Share the Fun acts will be scored by a panel of three judges. All participants will receive a certificate for participating.
- The top two finishers in each category will advance to compete at the District Level competition scheduled for May 16, 2015.
